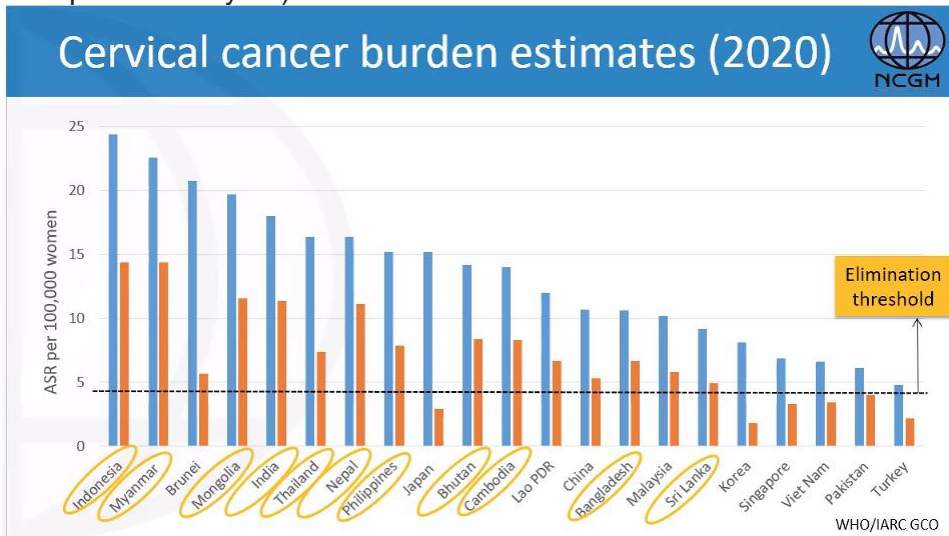
#### 1.1 SC5. Education/Training (leader: KR, Jong Soo)

- Sri Lanka (Harindra) plans to share an available list of seminars (NCI, IARC. CCV)
- JP (Tomohiro) plans to introduce the WHO Manila ex director Hairim
- KR (Jong Soo) highlighted that scholarships and UICC fellowship quota is mostly focused on ANCCA members, and agreed to disseminate to young researchers

#### 1.2 SC1. Cancer Policy and Control Program – Strategic Management (leader: Nepal, Kishore)

- JP (Tomohiro): Regarding cancer screening, international guidelines already exist for breast and cervical cancer. There is currently no concrete idea for setting up a specific project.

- BN (Sokking): ANCCA members could share expertise about evaluation of programs, incl. HPV vaccination
- SL (Harindra): ANCCA members could invite the Director of Center of GH at NCI from the region, educational, organized cancer screening, eg guideline for cervical cancer screening
- JP (Tomohiro): Research outcome would not be necessary, we could conduct report learnings such as, in 2-3 months cancer screening specific training
- JP (Rei): what about linking ANCCA with the NCGM program focusing on cervical cancer Survey on cervical cancer diagnosis and staging. The main topics for presentation are cervical cancer diagnostic and staging, staging classification, diagnostic methods (see extracted slide from the PPT presented by JP)



- Next actions: NP (Kishor, Kathmandu Cancer Center, previously Natl Cancer) may lead, with the support of other members to highlight the situation in Nepal, incl visual inspection, not organized, easy, economic. Oral cancer

### 1.3 SC2 NCCP:

- JP (Tomohiro): The draft survey will be completed then a paper will be drafted
- SL (Harindra): at next meeting the Director of NCCP in Sri Lanka will join next meeting and present from Sri Lanka

### 1.4 SC4 Registries –

- JP (Tomohiro): there are several candidates as leaders: Tata Memorial (as it was nominated as GICR collaborator IARC) and Myanmar
- Laos (Champadeng): the current activities in Laos focus on cancer centers activity, pathology to hospital base, data 2017-2021 complete and quality increasing, with issues on cancer registration

### 1.5 Other Subcommittees and comments from attending members

- ID (Erwin): ID is interested in UICC fellowship
- VN (Giang) is interested in participating as an active subcommittee in the SC4 cancer registry and would like to learn more about its activities and goals. VN is also interested in the NCCP subcommittees. This year, VN will apply for a UICC fellowship.
- MY (Suhana) is specifically interested in Clinical trials and Covid19 and could contribute as active member
- MY (Norbaya and Nor Saleha) are interested to join first as observer then contribute to SC2 and SC3 (cancer control and the Code against cancer)
- SG (Liang Kai and Taufiq): are interested to contribute to active subcommittees and to support as ANCCA secretariat team.
- JP (Laureline): SG, ID and JP should collaborate further to update the website incl pictures from ANCCA members
