1. 1st ANCCA Scientific Annual Conference

1.1. Discussion on general topics (presented by Prof William and Laureline)


- Virtual Platform for cancer networking and care (Chair by NCCP JP-SG)
 - Keynote speaker by Japan
 - Teleconsultation, platforms for referral of patients, processing of images by AI or otherwise, zoom as cancer networking, virtual conferences - to capture how these platforms enhance cancer prevention and care
 - Singapore plan to do a survey among ANCCA members and present the results summarizing the situation in the region
 - Dr Clar Cairo suggested Philippines to present the Project ECHO (Extension for community healthcare outcome) based in US <https://echo.cancer.org/>
 - Dr Sokking mentioned Brunei colleagues partake ECHO in Australia focuses on cervical cancer screening, treatment and vaccination.
 - Dr Manju mentioned that they run virtual tumour boards using ECHO, they also hold lots of platforms for training community health workers and trainers
 - Post meeting note: Chair to align with Dr Cairo, Dr Sokking and Dr Manju to discuss speaker(s) to talk on Project ECHO
- AI and Big Data in Cancer (chair by NCC-KR)
 - Keynote speaker by NCC-KR: To discuss with secretariat before the next meeting



- Dr Yawei Zhang (China) suggest a topic with development for primary and secondary cancer prevention and care, health management as part of their digitalized ongoing work and experience. She also suggested the incorporation of cancer registry in the session
 - Clinical Research – Essentials for setting up a clinical trial in Asia (chair by NCC-CN)
 - Keynote speakers: Experts from China
 - Seek other ANCCA members to present on progress of clinical trials in Asian countries
 - Suggestions to invite ATLAS for this conference
 - Prof William – Singapore: Dr Daniel Tan may be able to present on Thoracic Cancer
 - As a bigger picture (Dr Babu, Prof William) - cooperative clinical trial groups across ANCCA members representing a mixed group of Asian population. Such pan-Asian network taking would allow to target groups based on the different ethnicities as they may react differently to different investigational drugs or treatments.
 - Prevention and Screening (chair by NCC-B)
 - Keynote by IARC
 - ANCCA: Asian Code against Cancer
 - Screening programmes talks by ANCCA members who have collaborated with WHO, Suggestion for Dr Prakash – Nepal to share on cervical screening and HPV vaccination and send out survey to ANCCA members.
 - Dr Abhishek – APOCC: Environmental factors, occupation and cancer should be taken in consideration in the agenda. Specially in LMICs, prevention and screening are key. It is also important to focus on health promotion activities.
